Swindon Town Football in the Community Trust Privacy Policy for GDPR

Swindon Town Football in the Community Trust ("we", "our", "us") take your privacy very seriously.

This Privacy Notice sets out how we use and look after the personal information we collect from you. We are the data controller, responsible for the processing of any personal data you give us. We take reasonable care to keep your information secure and to prevent any unauthorised access to or use of it.

What personal data we hold on you – Relevance of obtaining Parental/guardian consent for minors

Personal data means any information about an individual from which that individual can be identified.

We collect, use, store and transfer some personal data of our participants (minors) and their parents or guardians.

You provide information about yourself when you register with the Trust, and by filling in forms at an event or online, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise.

The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, gender, and the contact details of a third party in the case of emergency. We may also ask for relevant health information, which is classed as special category personal data, for the purposes of your health, wellbeing, welfare and safeguarding. Where we hold this data it will be with the explicit consent of the participant or, if applicable, the participant's parent or guardian.

Where we need to collect personal data to fulfil Trust responsibilities and you do not provide that data, in the event of medical emergency, we may not be able administer correct treatment.

Why we need your personal data

We will only use personal data for any purpose for which it has been specifically provided.

The reason we need participants personal data is to be able to deliver our Trust activities and to provide the services that you are signing up to when you register with the Trust. Our lawful basis for processing your personal data is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a participant to provide the services you are registering for.

| Sharing data to provide information about renewals or invitation to social events | The Trust has a legitimate interest to maintain participant correspondence with consent |
| Sharing data with third party service or facility providers | The Trust has a legitimate interest to run the organisation efficiently and as it sees fit. Provision of some third party services is for the benefit of the Trust and participants |
| Sharing anonymised data with a funding partner as condition of grant funding e.g. Local Authority | The Trust has a legitimate interest to run the organisation efficiently and as it sees fit. Application for funding is a purpose that benefits the Trust and its participants. |
| Sending out marketing information such as newsletters and information about promotions and offers from sponsors | Consent. We will only send you direct marketing if you are an existing participant or other associated individual and you have not previously objected to this marketing, or, you have actively provided your consent. |
| To ensure we understand possible health risks | Consent. We will only process details on your medical history with your consent. |

Who we share your personal data with

We may disclose your personal information to coaches to comply with a legal obligation; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of our participants, or others.

The Trust's data processing may require your personal data to be transferred outside of the UK. Where the Trust does transfer your personal data overseas it is with the sufficient appropriate safeguards in place to ensure the security of that personal data.

Protection of your personal data

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the Trust. If you choose not to share your personal data with us we may not be able to register your/ your child's place.

We may update this Privacy Notice from time to time, and will inform you to any changes in how we handle your personal data.
